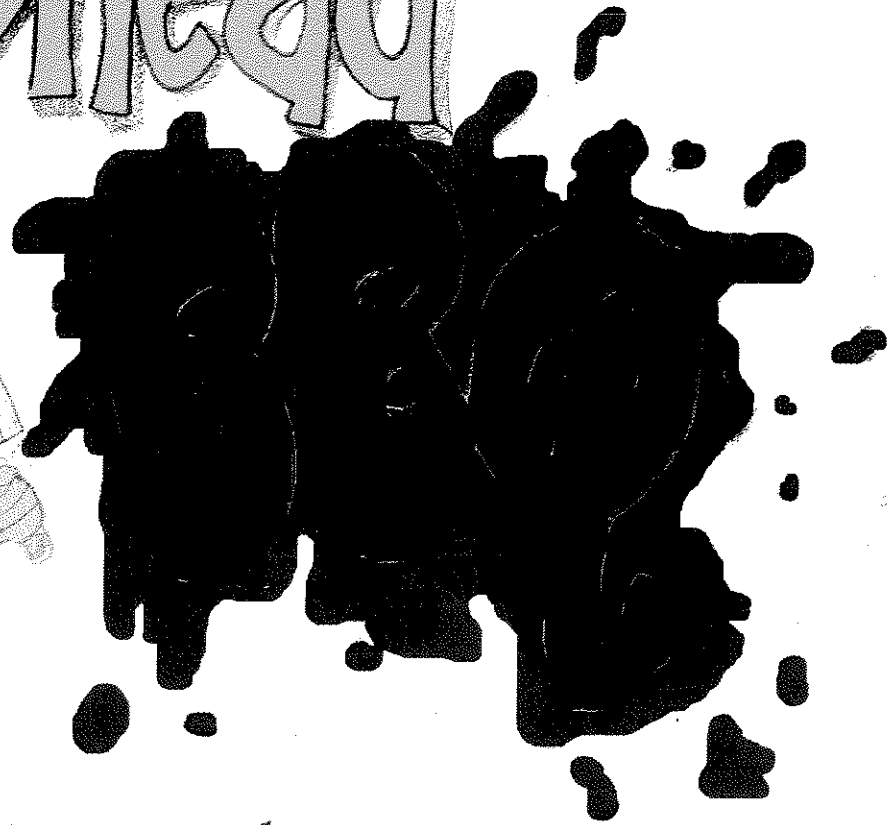
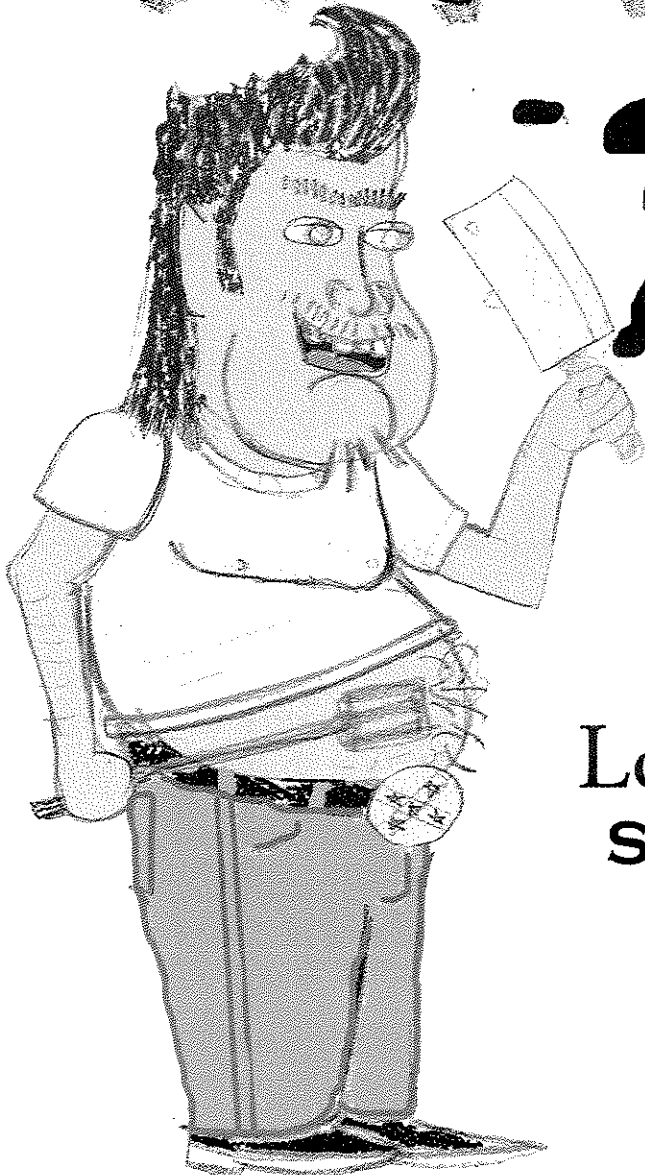

Rules & Regulations

Entry Fee:

The cook-off contestants will submit entry form for the categories Beef, Pork, or other. Entry fee is \$20 per contestant. The fee must be paid in full before a space can be reserved. The Cook-Off committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of the judges are final.

Categories: Beef, Pork, and Other

Set-up/Check-In time: The contestants may enter the cook-off area beginning at 8:00am until 10:00am to setup cooking equipment. Set-up must be completed by this designated time. NO vehicles allowed in or out after set-up. (Early set-up is recommended).

Booth/Site Area: The booth area for the cook-off will be located in the City Park in Schaller. The booth spaces will be designated by the name of each contestant. Each contestant will be allotted a 10x12 space.

Equipment: Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. Equipment must not exceed the boundaries of the assigned space. Each contestant is responsible for bringing extension cords. Fires must be wood/wood substance, or gas grills.

Cooking: Contestants must cook meat on site. All fires must be in containers. Contestants may use any type of charcoal or fuel desired. All food is to be handled in a sanitary manner using cooking utensils. Contestants will provide meat, seasonings & "special" ingredients.

All rules & guidelines will be followed. The judges will keep the official time and will be responsible for selecting a winner based on categories using a 5 point system.

Entries will be judged on Appearance/Display, Tenderness, & Taste
A point system will be used to determine winners from a scale of 1-5 with 5 being the highest score.

Each contestant will receive (1) container. Each container will have a double matched theater ticket, which has been affixed to the tray with masking tape.

The contestant only, will sign the back of the detachable ticket on each tray. The contestant is responsible for removing one of the tickets and keeping it in a safe place.

Turn in Times/Quantities: Turn in time for cook-off will be 1:30. Contestants will be responsible for delivering their entries to the designated turn-in judging area. Judging trays should be free of markings or damage. Trays must have ticket number attached!

House Keeping: All contestants must have means of catching drip grease and ashes from pit. Please do not dump coals, ashes, or grease on the ground. Cook-off space must be kept clean & returned to its original condition by the end of the cook-off or before leaving area.

Awards: All winners will receive trophies.
